

How much does a lithium ion battery cost?

Currently, 54% of the cell price comes from the cathode, 18% from the anode, and 28% from other components. The average price of lithium-ion battery cells dropped from \$290 per kilowatt-hour in 2014 to \$103 in 2023. In the coming months, prices are expected to drop further due to oversupply from China.

What is the difference between lithium ion battery prices and nickel prices?

Data until March 2023. Lithium-ion battery prices (including the pack and cell) represent the global volume-weighted average across all sectors. Nickel prices are based on the London Metal Exchange, used here as a proxy for global pricing, although most nickel trade takes place through direct contracts between producers and consumers.

How much does a battery cost in China?

On a regional basis, average battery pack prices were lowest in China, at \$94/kWh. Packs in the US and Europe were 31% and 48% higher, reflecting the relative immaturity of these markets, as well as higher production costs and lower volumes.

How have lithium-ion battery prices changed over the last 10 years?

Lithium prices, for example, have plummeted nearly 90% since the late 2022 peak, leading to mine closures and impacting the price of lithium-ion batteries used in EVs. How much do battery electric vehicles cost?

The figures represent an average across multiple battery end-uses, including different types of electric vehicles, buses and stationary storage projects. Prices for battery electric vehicles (BEVs) came in at \$97/kWh, crossing below the \$100/kWh threshold for the first time.

Lithium-ion battery pack prices dropped 20% from 2023 to a record low of \$115 per kilowatt-hour, according to analysis by research provider BloombergNEF (BNEF). Factors driving the decline include cell manufacturing overcapacity, economies of scale, low metal and component prices, adoption of lower-cost lithium-iron-phosphate (LFP) batteries ...
