Battery monitoring how to turn off the power

What is the low battery notification setting in power options?

The Low battery notification setting in Power Options allows users to turn on or off whether a notification is shown when battery capacity reaches the Low battery level. This tutorial will show you how to add or remove the Low battery notification setting under Battery in Power Options for all users in Windows 7, Windows 8, and Windows 10.

How do I Manage my battery & power settings?

You can further manage battery and power settings if you right-click on Battery saver and choose Go to Settings (or open Settings > System > Power &battery) The Power &battery screen shows the current charge for your battery,the estimated amount of time left before the charge is depleted,and the level over the past 24 hours.

How do I disable low and critical battery notifications?

Open Power Options and click 'Change plan Settings'. Expand the Battery section at the bottom of the resulting list. In that list you can disable the Low and Critical battery notifications. If you are not seeing the default Windows notifications about low battery, please provide a screenshot of the notification you are seeing.

How do I turn off my screen when running on battery?

Open Settings. Click on System. Click the Power & battery (or Power) page on the right side. Click the "Screen, sleep, & hivernate timeouts" setting. Use the "Turn my screen off after" setting under "On battery" to decide when the display should turn off when running on battery.

What is the battery setting in power options?

The Battery setting in Power Options allows you to configure notification and action settings you want when your battery reaches a set low and critical level.

How do I change low battery action?

To Change Low Battery Action This setting is to specify the action that your computer takes when the battery capacity reaches the low level you set in step 4 below. B) Select Do nothing (default), Sleep, Hibernate, or Shutdown for what you want in the On battery and Plugged in drop menus, and click/tap on Apply.

In case the battery monitor or Bluetooth interface firmware is older, this setting is called "Start synchronized" and offers the option to either turn it OFF (clear) or ON (set to 100%). State of ...

The best possible solution if possible is to supply power but not charge the battery, but this is no longer possible with MacBooks: in the past you could tape off one of the pins to prevent it from charging but still
