

How much does it cost to replace a start capacitor?

Once the start capacitor's job of starting the AC motor has been accomplished, it turns off, and the run capacitor steps in. Start capacitors typically cost \$9 to \$25. The average cost to replace start capacitors is \$110 to \$325. The run capacitor on an AC unit is often simply called an AC capacitor.

How much does AC capacitor replacement cost?

A local HVAC expert will charge between \$60 and \$200 in labor alone to replace your capacitor. Keep in mind that many professionals will charge a flat rate for an AC capacitor replacement, which includes the cost of the capacitor itself. Most commonly this all-inclusive flat rate will be between \$120 and \$250.

In addition to taking the necessary safety precautions, you'll need the right tools and skills for DIY AC capacitor replacement. In most cases, you only need a new capacitor, an insulated screwdriver, and a nut driver. Be sure to wear safety gloves and goggles, turn off the power supply before you start, and discharge the capacitor.

How much does a dual run capacitor cost?

You can usually tell when a dual-run capacitor needs to be replaced because it will start making loud noises and buzzing sounds. It may also show signs of visible damage. Dual-run capacitors typically cost \$15 to \$45, and the average cost to replace dual-run capacitors is \$160 to \$375. How do you know if you need a new AC capacitor?

Do AC capacitors have a warranty?

Capacitors are relatively affordable and usually don't have their own warranty. However, the manufacturer's warranty for your entire AC unit might cover capacitor replacement. Alternatively, if you have a home warranty that covers your AC unit, it may be less costly to submit a claim than to pay for the replacement yourself.

How long does AC capacitor replacement take?

AC capacitor replacement can usually be done in under two hours, as it's a relatively simple maintenance task. However, complex installations can take several hours, so it's best to call your HVAC technician when you suspect a faulty capacitor.

Most of the cost of replacing an AC capacitor is labor. The more accessible your HVAC unit is, the less you'll have to pay for service charges. An experienced HVAC technician can install a new AC capacitor in less than 30 minutes if it's easy to get to, and it could cost you as little as \$30 to \$60 in labor, depending on your location.
