Global exports of lithium-ion batteries increased between 2017 and 2019. While in 2017, lithium-ion batteries worth some 21.1 billion U.S. dollars were exported worldwide, the value of exports in 2019 was estimated at some 33.2 billion U.S. dollars. The overall value of lithium ion batteries exports increased by an average 13.4% for all exporting countries since 2018 when lithium ion batteries shipments were valued at \$2.88 billion. Year over year, revenues from exported lithium ion batteries slowed to a 1.7% gain from in 2022 compared to \$3.21 billion during 2021.

Which countries sell the most lithium batteries in 2021?

The fastest-growing sellers of lithium batteries from 2021 to 2022 are Kazakhstan (up 7,090%), Jordan (up 6,350%), Senegal (up 5,027%), Armenia (up 4,700%), Angola (up 2,940%) and Cyprus (up 2,850%).
