

Greece independent energy storage project bidding

Which energy storage projects will be included in Greece's energy tenders?

The program's first and second tenders will focus on standalone energy storage projects connected to the Greek electricity transmission network. The tenders exclude the island network of Crete, which was linked to Greece's mainland power grid in 2021.

How does Greece support energy storage projects?

Greece's subsidy support for winning energy storage projects in the upcoming tenders is generous. During the construction phase, all winning projects will receive a one-time payment of EUR200,000 per MW, which serves as a capital expenditure subsidy.

How many MW of new battery storage capacity does Greece have?

The Greek energy regulator has awarded 300 MW of new battery storage capacity in the nation's second energy storage tender, split among 11 projects. The tender is part of the country's 1 GW energy storage auction program. The projects range in size from 8,875 MW/17,75 MWh to 49,9 MW/100 MWh).

How much does an energy storage auction cost in Greece?

The projects range in size from 8,875 MW/17,75 MWh to 49,9 MW/100 MWh). The regulator said the auction was highly competitive, leading to an average tender price of EUR47,680 (\$51,506)/MW per year. Greece's energy storage auction program awards contracts-for-difference (CfD) over periods of 10 years.

Does Greece have a 1 GW energy storage program?

The auction is part of Greece's 1 GW energy storage program. The country announced its 1 GW energy storage program in the summer with three separate tenders featuring 400 MW, 300 MW and 300 MW of capacity. The first tender awarded 12 energy storage projects in August, with 411,79 MW of capacity in total.

When will Greece's second energy storage tender take place?

Greece's energy regulator has published a call for the country's second energy storage tender to take place in February 2024. Greece is gearing up for its second competitive auction for standalone, front-of-the-meter energy storage facilities connected to the electricity transmission network.

Seven companies have won government support for 11 standalone battery projects at Greece's second energy storage auction, where 300 MW was offered.

As Energy-Storage.news reported in March, developers are submitting energy storage projects in Greece for electricity market licenses in preparation for the auctions which will total 900MW, including the current ...

Among the projects opened for bidding this month, there were 11 independent energy storage projects, 10 new energy distribution storage projects, 7 framework procurement projects, and 1 customer project. Their respective capacity shares were 12%, 7%, 1%, and 80%. In terms of framework procurement projects, the bidding capacity reached 11GWh, mainly ...
