

How much does a rooftop solar system cost?

**Mounting system:** This is what holds rooftop solar panels in place. Costs vary depending on the type of solar installation, but it generally costs between 7 and 20 cents per watt. **Electrical wiring and hardware:** This includes the wiring, switches and circuit breakers required to connect the solar panel system to your home's electrical system.

What is a good price per watt for rooftop solar?

A good price per watt for rooftop solar provides a balance of savings potential and robust warranty and service coverage. Based on recent solar pricing trends from the SEIA, this balance can be found in the \$3-4 per watt range for residential solar projects.

How much does home solar cost?

The average pre-incentive cost of home solar is \$29,161 for a three-bedroom house, or \$20,412 after claiming the 30% tax credit. However, as shown in the chart below, the number of bedrooms isn't a great indicator of the size and cost of a solar system - and neither is living space, for that matter.

How much does a solar project cost?

After decades of falling dramatically, the cost of residential solar projects - measured in Price Per Watt (PPW) - bottomed out at \$2.92 per watt in 2019 and has increased slightly in the three years since to reach \$3.27 in the first half of 2023, according to data from the Solar Energy Industries Association (SEIA).

How much do solar panels cost per square foot?

On average, solar panels cost \$8.77 per square foot of living space, after factoring in the 30% tax credit. However, the cost per square foot varies based on the size of the home. For example, the post-tax credit cost of solar panels for a 2,500-square-foot home is around \$20,000 for a rate of \$7.96 per square foot.
