How much does it cost to replace a car battery?

On average, a flooded lead-acid battery will cost between \$185 and \$300, while an AGM battery can cost between \$250 and \$400. If you own a newer car, you may be wondering how much it would cost to replace the battery at a dealership. On average, labor costs are between \$50-\$100 depending on the dealership and the type of car.

How much does it cost to replace a Hyundai Kona electric battery?

Similar to the IONIQ, replacing the Hyundai KONA Electric battery should be an uncomplicated procedure. We estimate that the price of the 64 kWh battery pack replacement costs about \$10,000-\$12,000 (though the current market price for a battery pack at that size is closer to \$8,900).

How much does it cost to install a car battery?

Depending on the battery location in the car and how long it takes to install, a mechanic can charge \$10 to \$100 to install the car battery. However, many car part retailers will install the battery free of charge if you buy the battery from them.

How much does a Nissan Leaf battery replacement cost?
