

How to install snow removal clips for solar panels

How do you remove snow from solar panels?

The best way to remove snow from solar panels is simply with a snow removal rake. The easiest, safest option for most homeowners, are solar panel snow rakes. These feature a soft, rubbery rake attached to a long telescoping pole that helps you easily access roof-top panels safely from the ground.

Can I use a hose to remove snow from my solar panels?

If it is very cold outside we highly suggest that you do not use a hose to clean the snow off of your solar panels. If you like to minimize labor, you can install a warm water line or heater for snow removal. These will heat your solar panels up and melt all the snow covering them.

How do you keep snow from melting on solar panels?

You can add a warm water line to your solar panels. This heated water will increase the temperature on your panel, causing the snow to melt and slide off with ease. If you have an electrical heater installed within or underneath your solar panels, the energy harvested from the sun will power this heat source up.

How do you remove ice from a solar panel?

Another way to remove ice from a solar panel would be by applying heat to it. You can use a blowdryer, a portable heater, heat tape, or some other heating solution. If you are doing this manually on the roof be extra caution. The melting ice can be very slippery and you could sustain a severe injury from falling.

How do I get snow off my roof without damaging solar panels?

A roof rake with soft bristles will be the most effective to brush snow off without damaging the solar panels. You can also blow fluffy snow off with a leaf blower. This method can be dangerous because of the machinery you are using. Be sure to take extra precautions if using a leaf blower on your roof.

How do solar panels work if it snows?

After a heavy snow, the sun comes out and starts to warm everything up, including your solar panels. Solar panels are designed to shed snow. The deep black and blue colors help the panels absorb the sunlight's heat - melting the snow - and the extremely-slippery tempered glass encourages the snow to slide off.
