

How to install the battery panel on the speaker

How do you remove a battery from a speaker?

Using a Phillips #0 screwdriver, remove the ten 5.1mm screws that hold down the battery panel on the bottom of the speaker unit. Using your hands, pry the panel off of the top of the device to reveal the device circuit board and the battery attached to the inner side of the panel.

How do you install car speakers?

To install car speakers, start by disconnecting your car's battery to protect yourself and prevent electrical damage. Once you've disconnected the battery, use a flathead screwdriver to pry off the panels or grills covering your speakers. Unfasten any screws securing the speakers in place and disconnect the wires.

How do you wire a car speaker?

Again, use a screwdriver to push in the clasps on the top and bottom and it will then push into the interior. Run the speaker wire up the seatbelt column, and into the hole that this terminal blocked. On the exterior, use bailing wire to again pull the speaker wire down the rubber coil.

How do I install a new Speaker?

Secure the new speaker. Once you're confident that your speaker works properly, secure it in its seat in the door or dashboard. Ensure a sealed fit with mounting brackets, adapters and spacers. New holes may need to be drilled into the mounting location. Take care to avoid any other accessory wiring. Install and test any subwoofers.

How do you connect a speaker to a car door?

Reach into the empty speaker hole and pull your wire through. Just make sure to secure the speaker wire to the bottom interior (I used zip-ties) of the car door, because the window can rip out the speaker wire (more likely in the front doors). Now, reconnect the terminal housing.

How do you charge a speaker with a foot?

The foot should remain attached to the speaker only by its rubber tab, which is inserted into the speaker. Place the speaker on the charging cradle. Charge the battery for three hours or until the battery status indicator is solid green. You can use the speaker while the battery charges.
