

How to remove the battery panel of the hair clipper

How do you replace the battery in a hair Trimmer?

Luckily, it is also very easy to replace the battery in a hair trimmer. Remove the door to the casing outside the battery housing. Some doors are held in place with a screw, so unscrew it before trying to pry it open. Remove the old battery (or batteries) and dispose of it properly.

How do you remove a battery from a clipper?

Remove the battery up out of the clipper. Cut the red and black wires which lead to the battery. The battery is disposed of safely. **RECYCLING** To avoid environmental and health problems due to hazardous substances, appliances and rechargeable and non-rechargeable batteries marked with one of these symbols must not be disposed

How do you remove a hair clipper blade?

To remove blade, hold the clipper with front of blade teeth facing away. (clipper. and Maintenance section). ? To reattach blade, slide cartridge back into clipper body until it clicks. ? For detailing (see fig. 4). with the maximum comb attachment. the clipper through the hair against the direction the hair normally grows.

How to use a hair clipper?

to cut its way through the hair. Do not force it through quickly. If you are cutting for the first time, start with the maximum comb attachment. For one all over cut length, attach the desired guide comb and slowly guide the clipper through the hair against the direction the hair normally

How long does it take a hair clipper to charge?

with the maximum comb attachment. the clipper through the hair against the direction the hair normally grows. ? Clipper must be turned off. work downwards. ? The clipper will be fully charged in 3-5 hours.

How do you clean a Sid Burn on a hair clipper?

BATTERY REMOVAL o The battery must be removed from the appliance before it is scrapped. o The appliance must be disconnected from the supply mains when removing the battery. o Ensure the clipper is discharged of all power. o Remove vacuum chamber and blade. o Using a small screwdriver, remove 3 screws top of clipper where the vacuum

Remove the cap that adjusts the cut number, and proceed to brush the hair off the clipper, if you can't seem to properly clean it then proceed to insert a needle like pin, or a clip, and make sure you clean the device properly. If you have baby oil, clean the blade and the top of the hair clipper with a paper cotton pad, this will make the blades have more movement; One ...

It is recommended that you empty the vacuum chamber one it becomes full by pushing the vacuum chamber release button, pulling the chamber away from the clipper (See Figure A) and emptying the trimmings into a bin.
