Why do South Ossetians rely on 'illegality'?

South Ossetians sometimes rely on the 'illegality' of South Ossetia's inclusion in Georgia following the breakup of the Russian empire after the 1917 revolutions to avoid the application of the *uti possidetis* principle. The argument is that *uti possidetis* cannot override a prior illegality.

What occurred in South Ossetia?

South Ossetia was the main site of the August 2008 war between Georgian military forces and local South Ossetian forces, as well as the Russian military. Following the conflict, the Russian Federation recognized the territory as the South Ossetian Republic.

Is South Ossetia a state?

South Ossetia is considered a state by some entities, as evidenced by the Russian Federation's recognition of it as the South Ossetian Republic. This article reviews the contending scripts used to understand South Ossetia and the basis of its claim to be a state.
