How many solar panels will BSP have?

The 3.3 MWp utility-scale solar PV plant, will house about 7,000 solar panels, another outstanding achievement, especially for BSP. Once it operates, the low carbon electricity generated from these solar panels will offset some of the energy used in the BSP Headquarters building, Jalan Utara, Panaga.
