Do I need permission to install panels? You do not need formal planning permission (un permis de construire) but the intention to put installations on roofs (and those on the ground higher than 1.8m) needs to be notified to the local mairie, which has the right to object, via a d&#233;claration pr&#233;alable de travaux.
