

Does Zimbabwe have a lithium industry?

Currently, Chinese lithium miners, who dominate the sector in Zimbabwe, only produce lithium concentrates which they ship to China for further processing. Last November, Zimbabwe's finance minister Mthuli Ncube said the government had given miners up to March 2024 to submit plans on refining within the country.

Can Zimbabwe produce battery-grade lithium?

The company says Zimbabwe lacks resources needed to produce battery-grade lithium, including reliable renewable energy, natural gas and sulphuric acid. Zimbabwe has, however, insisted on local refining as it seeks to capitalise on projected growth in lithium demand as the world shifts to cleaner energy sources.
